 3 **able to avail of the Net Metering Service Option because of the absence of a meter.**  
 4 **Rate 4.1: Street Area Lighting Service is given as an example of a service where net**  
 5 **metering is not possible. Please provide a list of all other unmetered services that**  
 6 **will not be able to avail of net metering.**

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 13 Newfoundland Power provides service to 1,822 unmetered service points.<sup>1</sup> Of the total  
 14 unmetered services 79% are related to the telecommunications industry which provides  
 15 telephone, television and internet services. These services are primarily power supplies  
 16 for repeater stations which are located on utility poles. Municipal Services, such as  
 17 traffic lights, crosswalks and bus shelters, account for 19% of the unmetered services.  
 18 The remaining 2% reflect a wide range of other services including: navigation and area  
 19 lighting, fire siren, video surveillance equipment, lift bridge and hospital x-ray machines.  
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21 For confidentiality reasons, Newfoundland Power objects to providing a list of customers  
 22 who have these unmetered services.
