- Q. In reference to IBEW-NP-005, please explain the process of "geo-adjusting" market group data for Newfoundland for non-union employee salaries. Does geo-adjusting result in higher or lower salaries than the market group data?
- A. In reference to IBEW-NP-005, the process of "geo-adjusting" market group data for Newfoundland for non-union employee salaries is completed using the Geographic Assessor of the Economic Research Institute ("ERI"). The ERI Geographic Assessor is used by Willis Towers Watson in their assessment of Newfoundland Power's Managerial Compensation Structure and market medians for base salaries.
- The ERI reported the regional difference in compensation data in the city of St. John's to be 5% lower than the national market data.
