3		Please describe the specific parameters used by each of these six sources listed
4		on Page 42 to calculate the beta coefficients that Dr. Booth has relied upon in
5		his CAPM analysis. Also, are these betas adjusted or raw?

7	A.	This statement is incorrect Dr. Booth did not rely on any external beta estimates; he
8		relied on his own original research and judgement. Dr. Booth provided externa
9		beta estimates as a "check" as is clearly stated at line 8, page 42. Dr. Booth believes
10		that any expert witness should provide the Board with a full range of evidence and
11		not "cherry pick" a particular source that supports their judgement.
12		
13		Dr. Booth is not aware as to whether the betas were estimated by each individual
14		research company or provided to them by a third party. He is aware that Yahoo uses
15		Standard and Poors Capital IQ data.
16		
17		The betas are provided as generally available independent beta estimates by
18		reputable services, which are in the public domain. They are presumably relied on
19		otherwise, they would not be provided. In this sense, they are similar to Consensus
20		Economic's interest rate forecasts.
