c) The proposed investments in EV charging infrastructure are justified based on the rate mitigating benefits that would be provided to the Company's customers. These investments are consistent with the least-cost delivery of reliable service and are appropriate for a regulated utility such as Newfoundland Power. Additionally, if approved, the Board would have oversight of the costs and revenues from Newfoundland Power's EV Charging Network.
