2		Power's operating cost per customer is forecast to be approximately 16% less in 2023
3		than it was in 2011." How does the 2023 figure compare to 2020?

5 A. When adjusted for inflation, Newfoundland Power's operating cost per customer is 6 forecast to be approximately 0.9% less in 2023 than it was in 2020.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> On an inflation-adjusted basis, Newfoundland Power's operating cost per customer is approximately \$235 in 2020 and \$233 in 2023 forecast [(\$233 - \$235) / \$235 = -0.0085, or approximately -0.9%].
