8 9 10 11	A.	The July 1, 2021 customer rate increase has no material impact on the average increase in customer rates proposed in the Company's <i>2022/2023 General Rate Application</i> . This is due to the inclusion of the estimated July 1, 2021 rate increase effects in the forecast of energy sales. ¹
