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- 1 **NLH-NP-001** a) Please confirm that the Memorial University of Newfoundland (“MUN”) St. John’s  
2 campus is considered a single customer by Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland  
3 Power”) and the facilities on the MUN St. John’s campus are served by electrical  
4 system assets owned by MUN.
- 5 b) Does Newfoundland Power consider redundant supply a special facility under  
6 Clause 9(c) of Newfoundland Power’s Schedule of Rates, Rules, and Regulations?
- 7 c) Does Newfoundland Power normally charge a contribution when investment in assets  
8 are required to provide redundant supply to a customer? If yes, please explain the  
9 circumstances when contributions for redundant supply are required. If no, why not?
- 10 **NLH-NP-002** a) Is Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) planning to charge a  
11 contribution to Memorial University of Newfoundland (“MUN”) for the provision of  
12 the new transformer to provide redundant supply to the MUN electrical system? If  
13 yes, please provide the calculation of the contribution that will be requested.
- 14 b) If Newfoundland Power is not planning to charge a contribution to MUN, please  
15 explain why not, and why it is appropriate that the cost of the transmission assets  
16 invested to provide redundant service to serve a single customer should be recovered  
17 from all customers in the customer class.
