Q. (Reference Application) What is the difference between a capital budget cap and a capital budget envelope as proposed by Midgard?

A. A capital budget cap typically refers to a legislated cap on annual capital spending, whereas a capital budget envelope, as discussed by Midgard, is an amount of capital spending that is approved by a regulatory body following a review of proposed expenditures.<sup>1</sup> The Company views both capital budget caps and capital budget envelopes as arbitrary limits on capital expenditures and notes that neither are best practice in jurisdictions with cost of service regulation such as Newfoundland and Labrador.<sup>2</sup>
