It is stated "Hydro also applies Newfoundland Power's CIAC Policy to its Domestic and General Service customers." Does Hydro apply Newfoundland Power's CIAC policy to customers that are directly connected to its transmission system? Does Hydro apply Newfoundland Power's CIAC policy to upgrades for facilities that are specifically-assigned to a customer?

A. Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's ("Hydro") adoption of Newfoundland Power Inc.'s ("Newfoundland Power") Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") Policy as the basis of Hydro's CIAC Policy began as a result of Orders in Council OC299-'80 and OC1421-'87. Hydro applies Newfoundland Power's CIAC Policy to Hydro's Domestic and General Service customers. As Newfoundland Power correctly noted in its response to CA-NP-164 of this proceeding, Specifically Assigned Charges are a component of Hydro's Industrial-Firm rate design, applicable to Hydro's assets that serve individual Industrial customers as set out in Hydro's Schedule of Rates, Rules and Regulations.¹
