

1 Q. **Reference: CA-NP-164**

2 It is stated “*Hydro also applies Newfoundland Power’s CIAC Policy to its Domestic and General*
3 *Service customers.*” Does Hydro apply Newfoundland Power’s CIAC policy to customers that are
4 directly connected to its transmission system? Does Hydro apply Newfoundland Power’s CIAC
5 policy to upgrades for facilities that are specifically-assigned to a customer?

8 A. Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro’s (“Hydro”) adoption of Newfoundland Power Inc.’s
9 (“Newfoundland Power”) Contribution in Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) Policy as the basis of
10 Hydro’s CIAC Policy began as a result of Orders in Council OC299-’80 and OC1421-’87. Hydro
11 applies Newfoundland Power’s CIAC Policy to Hydro’s Domestic and General Service customers.
12 As Newfoundland Power correctly noted in its response to CA-NP-164 of this proceeding,
13 Specifically Assigned Charges are a component of Hydro’s Industrial-Firm rate design, applicable
14 to Hydro’s assets that serve individual Industrial customers as set out in Hydro’s Schedule of
15 Rates, Rules and Regulations.¹
