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3 **Q. (Schedule B) What happened to the Rate #2.2 customer class, and when, and for**
4 **what reason, was it abandoned?**

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6 A. In the *2013/2014 General Rate Application*, Newfoundland Power proposed to merge
7 Rate 2.1 and Rate 2.2 into a single rate class to eliminate the relatively large pricing
8 differences which could result for similar electricity usage under the two rate classes at
9 that time.¹

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11 In Order No. P.U. 13 (2013), the Board ordered that Rates 2.1 and 2.2 be merged into a
12 General Service Rate for all customers with demands of less than 100kW.²
