3 **Q. (Rules and Regulations, para. 7(n)) Are all Newfoundland Power customers metered**  
4 **at the distribution voltage level including customers served directly from the**  
5 **transmission system? What billing adjustments are made if metering is at the**  
6 **transmission voltage level?**

8 A. Newfoundland Power’s *Schedule of Rates, Rules & Regulations* states at 7 (n): “Metering  
9 shall normally be at secondary distribution voltage level but may at the option of the  
10 Company be at the primary distribution level. When metering is at the primary  
11 distribution voltage (4 - 25 kV) the monthly demand and energy consumption shall be  
12 reduced by 1.5%.”<sup>1</sup> Newfoundland Power does not meter customers at the transmission  
13 level.
