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- 2 3 A detailed description of the MUN Substation Refurbishment and Modernization Q. 4 project included in Newfoundland Power's 2024 Capital Budget Application is given 5 in Schedule B, pages 67-70. Newfoundland Power states (page 69) that continued 6 deferral of the project is not viable " ... as it would increase risks to the delivery of 7 safe and reliable service to the University" and that is followed by "The Memorial 8 Substation Refurbishment and Modernization project will mitigate risks to the delivery 9 of reliable service to the Company's largest customer." Newfoundland Power also 10 states (page 70) "Addressing deteriorated and obsolete equipment identified through 11 an engineering assessment will support the continued delivery of reliable service to the Company's largest customer." Because these statements do not identify any other 12 13 customer that benefits from the MUN Substation, is it accurate to say that that 14 Memorial University is the only customer that benefits from the MUN Substation and would be the only customer adversely affected by its failure? 15 16
- A. No, it is not accurate to say that Memorial University is the only customer that benefits
 from the Memorial ("MUN") Substation and would be the only customer adversely
