12	A.	b) Concentric was not provided, nor did it request, studies of the price elasticity of
13		demand by Newfoundland Power prior to the filing of our cost of capital report,
14		Volume 2. Concentric reviewed the referenced discussion of the price elasticity of
15		demand for electricity in preparing the response to CA-NP-240. Based upon our
16		review, the study discussed in Newfoundland Power's response to PUB-NP-103
17		appears reasonable, and is consistent with similar studies on price elasticity of
18		demand that Concentric has seen in the past for other electric utilities.
