Dr. Booth is not an engineer and a deep analysis of this is beyond his expertise. He is aware of the problem and the decision of Newfoundland Hydro to keep the Holyrood generating plant in service until the reliability is resolved. Dr. Booth considers this a short run problem that will be solved by capable engineers, where the main risk is the financial cost involved and its impact on rates. Although important, the financial cost is not as significant as the existing cost of Muskrat Falls.
