

1 **Q. Further to the response to PUB-NP-011, please restate Table 1 to include 2023**
2 **actuals.**

3
4 A. Newfoundland Power requires inputs from its annual cost of service study to complete its
5 operating costs per customer comparison to the U.S. peer group of companies. The 2023
6 Cost of Service study is not anticipated to be completed until mid-year once the required
7 inputs are finalized.

8
9 The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC”) requires major electric utilities
10 under its jurisdiction to annually file prescribed information regarding their operations
11 based on a FERC-defined system of accounts. The required information for 2023 will not
12 be available in the FERC database until April 18, 2024.

13
14 As such, Newfoundland Power does not have the necessary information to provide the
15 operating costs per customer comparison to the U.S. peer group of companies for 2023.

17 Newfoundland Power will file its *2023 Peer Group Performance Measures for*
18 *Newfoundland Power* report with the Board once all the required inputs become
19 available.
