A. Newfoundland Power's 2023 actual labour for Distribution was \$7,559,000, an increase of \$317,000 or 4.4% as compared to the test year. The increase is primarily due to operating labour associated with distribution line inspections and vegetation management, as well as for training and education. The increase was partially offset by lower distribution overtime labour costs.

Distribution labour associated with employee training and education reflects the return to normal training following COVID-19 restrictions. It includes training such as risk management and job safety planning code and traffic control requirements.
