

1 **Q. (Reference CA-NP-008, Attachment A) Please expand the table for the period**
2 **2000 to 2027F identifying the Average All-in Rate in cents/kWh, the amounts**
3 **contributed to the rate increase by NP and by Hydro in cents/kWh, the annual**
4 **percentage change, and the CPI average annual percentage inflation increase**
5 **“for all items” in each year both for NL and for Canada.**

7 **A.** Newfoundland Power does not have the specific analysis outlined in this Request for
8 Information available to provide. The Company can provide that 69% of current
9 customer rates are associated with the recovery of purchased power costs from Hydro,
10 with the remainder associated with Newfoundland Power’s costs.¹ The Company can
11 also provide that purchased power costs as a percentage of overall customer rates have
12 increased since 2000.²
