### AN INTERIM ORDER OF THE BOARD

16	pursuant to Sections 70 and 71 of the Act.

19	WHEREAS Hydro is a corporation continued and existing under the Hydro Corporation Act, is
20	a public utility within the meaning of the Act, and is subject to the provisions of the EPCA; and
21	
22	WHEREAS on December 20, 2007 Hydro filed the within application with the Board seeking
23	approval of these new rates for the sale of power and energy to Island Interconnected customers
24	(Rate Class 1.1, 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, 2.4 and 4.1), Isolated Rural Domestic customers, excluding
25	Government departments (Rate Class 1.2D), General Service Customers (Rate Class 2.1D and
26	2.2D), and Isolated Rural street and area lighting (Rate Class 4.1D), to be implemented effective
27	January 1, 2008 (the "Application"); and

29	WHEREAS the proposed rates reflect a number of factors including a change flowing from the rate
30	changes approved for Newfoundland Power in Order No. P.U. 32(2007), and Government Directives
31	by way of Order in Council, pursuant to the Act and previous orders of the Board; and

33	WHEREAS the specific amounts of the proposed rates are derived by the operation of various
34	methodologies established by previous orders of the Board as well as other Government Directives
35	established by way of Order in Council; and
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WHEREAS Hydro has advised that the rates proposed for Non-Government Rural Isolated Domestic and General Service customers are consistent with the Government's direction; and

WHEREAS Hydro advised that the rates proposed for the Domestic Labrador Isolated and L'Anse au Loup remain subject to the rebate put in place by Order No. P.U. 21(2007) and Order in Council; and

WHEREAS a determination as to whether the proposed rates are reasonable and appropriate will involve the review and application of the various Orders in Council and orders of the Board for each of the classes of customers; and

WHEREAS the comprehensive review of this Application by the Board may involve requests for further information and analysis or other processes to ensure that all possible issues raised by the Application are fully addressed and clarified:

WHEREAS the existing rates for certain customers are no longer applicable after January 1, 2008, and therefore Hydro will not be entitled to charge for service without an order of the Board approving rates pursuant to the *Act*; and

WHEREAS if after a full review of the matter it is determined that excess revenue has been earned by Hydro as a result of an interim order the Board may, pursuant to section 75 of the *Act* order that the customers of Hydro receive a refund or that the excess revenue be placed in a reserve account for that purpose; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that it is reasonable and appropriate to approve the rates proposed by Hydro on an interim basis to balance Hydro's interest in having established rates for service with the customers' interests in receiving least cost power.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Board approves on an interim basis the rates as attached in Schedule A to be effective for consumption on and after January 1, 2008 until a final order of the Board with respect to the within matter.
- 2. The continuation of the rebate to Hydro's domestic customers served from the Labrador Isolated and L'Anse au Loup (Labrador Straits) system is approved on an interim basis.
- 3. Hydro shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.

For Service (excluding Domestic Service) where the maximum demand occurring in the 12 months ending with the current month is 10 kilowatts or greater but less than 100 kilowatts (110 kilovolt-amperes).

Rate: (Including Municipal Tax and Rate Stabilization Adjustments)

\$8.64 per kW of billing demand in the months of December, January, February and March and \$7.14 per kW in all other months. The billing demand shall be the maximum demand registered on the meter in the current month.
