12 **WHEREAS** on March 30, 2015 Royal and Sun Alliance Insurance Company of Canada applied  
13 to the Board for approval to introduce a \$4,000,000 Third Party Liability limit for its Interurban  
14 Vehicles class of business; and

16 **WHEREAS** on April 8, 2015 Royal and Sun Alliance Insurance Company of Canada filed a  
17 revised application; and


19 **WHEREAS** the proposed changes will extend the level of existing coverages offered by Royal


25 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

29 effective no sooner than July 1, 2015 for new business and September 1, 2015 for renewals.


