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15	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly

and

WHEREAS on November 19, 2018 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") to provide single-phase service to a recreational vehicle park operated by Destination RV Resort Inc. (the "Customer"), located off the Trans-Canada Highway, west of Salmonier Line, by constructing a 2,158 metre single-phase line extension to an existing line for which another customer paid a CIAC approved by the Board in Order No. P.U. 4(2016); and

organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a

public utility within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA;

 WHEREAS Clause 5(c) of the CIAC Policy: Distribution Line Extensions and Upgrades to General Service Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 27(2005) (the "Policy") requires that the CIAC be calculated as if service was connected to the customer when the existing line was originally placed in service; and

WHEREAS the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the Policy, including the CIAC to be paid by the Customer in respect of the existing line and calculated in accordance with Clause 5(c) of the Policy, is one hundred and five thousand four hundred and sixty-eight dollars (\$105,468.00), excluding HST; and

WHEREAS Clause 10(i) of the Policy states that the company shall apply to the Board for approval of all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs where the construction costs are estimated to be greater than \$50,000; and

WHEREAS the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's investment is compensatory over the useful life of the upgrade and will not be to the detriment of its other customers.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of one hundred and five thousand four hundred and sixty-eight dollars (\$105,468.00), excluding HST, to provide single-phase service to a recreational vehicle park operated by Destination RV Resort Inc. is approved.

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2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
