20	Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") for a single-phase extension of approximately
21	1,421 metres (the "Extension") to serve Domestic Customers located in a cottage area known as

23 24	WHEREAS the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the CIAC Policy

26	"Policy") is six thousand six hundred forty-three dollars and fourteen cents (\$6,643.14)

29	WHEREAS Clause 10(i) of the Policy states all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs
30	where the costs calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) are estimated to be greater than \$50,000

33	WHEREAS the sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) and the Basic Investment
34	calculated pursuant to Clause 3 is \$52,977; and
