## AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

NO. A.I. 135(2020)

## IN THE MATTER OF the Automobile

Insurance Act, RSNL 1990, c. A-22, as amended, and regulations thereunder; and

IN THE MATTER OF an application
by The Dominion of Canada General
Insurance Company for approval to implement a revised rating program for its Public Vehicles category of automobile insurance.

WHEREAS on October 27, 2020 The Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company ("Dominion") applied to the Board for approval of a revised rating program under the Mandatory Simplified filing option for its Publics Vehicles category of automobile insurance; and

WHEREAS the proposal includes the following types of Public Vehicles: (i) Buses and (ii) Funeral Vehicles; and

WHEREAS Dominion does not have sufficient volume to perform any actuarial analysis for Public Vehicles; and

WHEREAS Dominion proposed no rating program changes; and
WHEREAS the Board finds that the proposal is made in accordance with the Board's Mandatory Simplified Filing Guidelines; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The revised rating program received October 27, 2020 from The Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company for its Public Vehicles category of automobile insurance is approved to be effective no sooner than January 1, 2021 for new business and renewals.
