revised rating program for its Commercial class of business, and

WHEREAS, the Board, after due examination and analysis of the
proposed rating program, finds that it should be approved as filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. Board Order No. A. I. 17 (2000-2001) be and it is hereby rescinded.
2. Approval be and it is hereby granted The Dominion of Canada General Insurance Company for the implementation of a revised rating program for its Commercial class of business with base rates as follows:

and differentials as submitted with this filing.

3. The following discount is approved for use subject to the eligibility criteria set out in the company's underwriting manual:

(i) Dual Policy	5%	All coverages – Classes 35- 46 and Class 75
