AND

IN THE MATTER OF the application
by Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro
(the “Applicant”) for approval of a contribution in
aid of construction for the supply of single-phase
electrical service to a Chlorination Building at Hampden.

WHEREAS paragraph 11 (a) of the Contribution in Aid of Construction Policy for distribution line extensions and upgrades to general service customers, as approved by the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (the “Board”) effective October 1, 1997, requires the Applicant to apply to the Board for approval of all distribution line extensions involving contributions in aid of construction where the construction costs are estimated to be greater than \$25,000.00; and

WHEREAS Atlantic Engineering Consultants Limited has applied to Hydro on behalf of the Town of Hampden (the “Customer”) for single-phase electrical service to the new Chlorination Building at Hampden, and the Applicant calculated the contribution in aid of construction to be \$42,770.00 plus \$6,415.50 HST for a total of \$49,185.50; and

WHEREAS the application dated September 30th, 2002 was received by the Board on October 3rd, 2002, and on December 4th, 2002, the Board met to consider the application and determine if the calculation is in accordance with the Contribution in Aid of Construction Policy.

WHEREAS the new line extension will not be used by Aliant Telecom Inc. or any other service company at this time; and

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The Applicant's application of \$49,185.50 total contribution in aid of construction for the supply of single-phase electrical service to the new Chlorination Building at Hampden, Newfoundland and Labrador is hereby approved.
